

## ***Frankenstein: Paper #1***

Take the common saying—"Ignorance is Bliss"—and write a paper about how Mary Shelley supports or refutes this argument.

**Step 1:** In intro write about what the saying—"Ignorance is Bliss"—means. Rewrite the saying as an argument that easy to understand. Talk about real life examples that you can apply this saying to. Make it clear what the saying is.

At the end of this paragraph transition to whether or not Mary Shelly agrees with the statement.

**Step 2:** Find 2 – 3 instances where one can infer this argument in the novel. Write 2-3 short paragraphs on each of these instances. Make sure that you don't merely quote, but be sure that you actually explain those quotations. Be sure to bring it back to the idea of Ignorance is Bliss.

**Step 3:** In the conclusion paragraph, you should agree or disagree with the statement and Mary Shelley's argument. This paragraph should be short, so make sure that you state whether or not you agree. And then provide example(s) to support your argument.

This paper should be around 2 pages.
