NOTES:

- Works Cited page is the last page of your paper.
- It includes only the sources that you use in your paper. You might have had 10 sources, but if you use only 4 of them, then you should have only 4 citations on the Works Cited.
- Follow the examples above. Look on my website for more examples.
- Double space entire Works Cited
- Make sure you indent every line but the first one of each entry
- Make sure you alphabetize the entries.
- Notice where the periods go.
- Make sure that the URLs look like the ones above. Remove hyperlink. This normally can be done by pressing UNDO button after the computer automatically creates hyperlink.
